



PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT 2016

"For the Good of the Game"

This code of conduct shall apply to parents and guardians. Any breach there of shall be subject to disciplinary action by the BRD Committee and the FFV Tribunal.

1. Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
2. Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
3. Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
4. Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
5. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or costing a game.
6. Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good play by all teams.
7. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
8. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
9. Show appreciation of coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
10. Commit to the travelling that is involved for the games and training.
Training sessions and/or matches are considered compulsory for all squad members. Any inability to attend must be communicated personally to the coaches if unavailable.
Failure to do so will jeopardize selection.
11. Refrain from coaching the players. The coaches have been selected to perform this role. It is critical that the players think for themselves and learn from the experience.
12. Players are required to arrive at games in the BRD pre match uniform if available.
13. BRD fully support the FFV approach to Zero Tolerance for inappropriate and Un- sportsman like conduct. With this objective in mind, BRD require that all fines, Penalties and costs are to be paid by the player (if over 18) or by the Parents/Guardians of a Junior players should either party (player or parents/guardians) be the cause and are subsequently found guilty of such offences. If a penalty is incurred the player will be stood down from the squad until such time as the fines are paid in full.
14. All escalation must be communicated via the Team Manager
15. The posting of critical or derogatory comments regarding the club on social media is expressly forbidden.
